

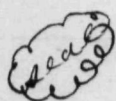

State of Maryland Caroline County to wit; Whereas application hath been made to me by a negro man named John Henry Friend for a certificate of his freedom agreeably to the act of assembly in such case made and provided, by which said act free negroes and mulattoes are permitted to travel out of this state upon the obtaining of a certificate of being free born, and whereas also upon the oath of Abel Gowdy of Caroline County that the said negro man named John Henry Friend for whom this certificate is made was free born, I do therefore grant his said application and hereby certify that from his own account he will be twenty three years of age the fifteenth day of August next, five feet six inches high or thereabouts of a black complexion, was born and raised in Caroline County, and has a tolerable large scar on the upper part of his right arm, and two small scars on his forehead, and has a natural mark nearly in the left temple, and no other noble marks or scars that I have observed. —
