

State of Maryland, Caroline County, Court; Whereas application hath been made to me by a negro man named Emalls Bromwell for a certificate of his freedom, agreeably to the acts of Assembly in such case made and provided; by which said act free negroes and mulattoes are permitted to travel out of this State upon the obtention of a certificate of being free born; And whereas also upon the oath of Margaret Black of Caroline County that the said negro man named Emalls Bromwell for whom this certificate is made, was free born; I do therefore grant his said application, and hereby certify that from his own account, he is about twenty one years of age, five feet and two inches high or thereabouts, was born and raised in Caroline County, of a black complexion, and has no notable marks or scars that I can discover. —

State of Maryland, Caroline County, Court; Whereas heretofore, to wit; on the first day of August Eighteen hundred and eight, a certain Abraham Imp of Caroline County by deed of Manumission duly executed acknowledged and recorded among the Land Records of Caroline County, did manumit and set free a certain negro woman named Lucretia and her issue whence they arrive to the age of eighteen years; and the said negro woman named Henry being the issue of the above named Lucretia, having made application to me for a certificate of her freedom, agreeably to the act of Assembly in such case made and provided, and whereas also up the oath of Francis Imp of Caroline County, that the said negro woman named Henry for whom this certificate is made is free; I do therefore grant her said application and hereby certify that from her own account she is about twenty four years of age, five feet three and one half inches high or thereabouts, of a black complexion, was born and raised in Caroline County, has a small scar of a cut on her left cheek, and seven or eight scars of a burn on her right arm, and some of them tolerable large, and has no other notable marks or scars that I have observed. —
