 permitted to travel out of this State upon the obtaining of a certificate of being free born,
 and whereas also upon the oath of Ebenezer Fountain of Caroline County, that the said negro man
 named Henry Hammond for whom this certificate is made was free born, I do therefore
 grant his said application and hereby certify that from his own account he was twenty two years
 of age in January last, five feet three and one fourth inches high or thereabouts, of a dark
 mulatto complexion, was born and raised in Caroline County, and has a large scar of a cut
 on his left knee, and a small scar just between his two eye brows, and has no other notable
 marks or scars that I have observed.

 negroes and mulattos are permitted to travel out of this State upon the obtaining
 of a certificate of being free born, and whereas also upon the oath of John Talbot
 of Caroline County, that the said negro woman named Harriet Downes for whom
 this certificate is made, was free born, I do therefore grant her said application
 and hereby certify that from her own account she is about twenty six years of
 age, four feet, ten and one half inches high or thereabouts, of a mulatto complexion,
 was born and raised in Caroline County and has no notable marks or scars that
 I have observed.
