22nd day of July 1859, a certain William Thomas of Caroline County
State aforesaid by a deed of Manumission duly executed acknowledged and recorded in one of the
books of Caroline County, aforesaid did manumit
and set free a certain negro man named William A. Thomas to
be free on and after the 22nd day of July 1859. And whereas application
hath been made to me by a negro man now present calling himself
William Alfred Thomas for a Certificate of his freedom agreeably to
law and whereas on the oath of James P. Burley hath been proven
that the said William A. Thomas is the same negro man mentioned
in the said deed of Manumission and is now free. I do therefore
grant this Certificate, He is now about twenty one years of age,
five feet ^{one}/_{three} quarters of an inch high or thereabouts of a Middle Complexion
neither tanned nor blacked in this County & has no notable marks or scars that
I have observed. In testimony whereof I hereunto subscribe my name &
affix the seal of the Circuit Court for Caroline County this nineteenth
day of June Anno Domini 1860.

hath made application to me for a Certificate of her freedom agreeably
to law; and whereas on the oath of William O'Conor hath been
proven that said Susan Ann Thomas was free born. I do therefore grant
this Certificate, She is now about thirty five years of age five feet ^{one}/_{two} inches high or thereabout of a Chestnut Complexion was born &
raised in Caroline County and has no notable marks or scars
that I have observed
