

Was Manumitted by Mrs Sarah Lane of Caroline County
to be free and at perfect liberty on the 25th day of December then
next following as by the said Manumission remaining of record
in Caroline County, reference being thereto had well appear; and
Whereas the said Negro Prip hath made application to me for
a Certificate of her freedom agreeable to act of Assembly. Upon
the oath of Mr William Hooper that the said Negro Woman
Prip, is the identical person who was Manumitted as aforesaid; I do
hereby Certify, that the said Negro Woman called Prip is five feet
four inches high and very stout made, and from the age expressed
in the Manumission of. She is about thirty eight years of age, she
is of a Dark Complexion was born in Queen Anne County and
raised untill she was about 13 or 14 years of age, and afterwards
in Caroline, has a small scar on her right Arm above her Elbow
which goes Crosswise, and also a small one on the under part of the
Right Arm which runs lengthwise, and also one on the outside of the
back of her right ankle, and no other notable marks which I
can discover
