Whereas application hath been made to me by a negro woman named Sarah Farrell for a Certificate of her freedom agreeably to an act of the General Assembly of Maryland passed at Annapolis the 18th of September 1818 by which said act free negroes and molattoes are permitted to travel out of this State upon their obtaining of a certificate of being free born and whereas also upon the Oath of Solomon Phippen of Caroline County aforesaid that the said negro woman Sarah Farrell for whom this Certificate is made was free born I do therefore grant her said application and hereby Certify that she is five feet three inches high or thereabouts. says she is about thirty years of age her complexion nearly black. was born & raised in Caroline County has lost several of her upper fore teeth and has no other notable mark or scar that I have discovered.
