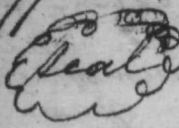
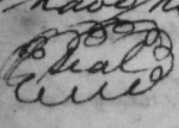

And Whereas the said negro woman called Henry has made application to me for a Certificate of her freedom, agreeably to the act of assembly in such cases made and provided and I being satisfied by the oath of Phillimon Leary, that the said negro woman for whom this Certificate is made, is the identical negro woman mentioned in the said manumission, I do therefore grant her said application, and hereby certify that the said negro Henry is five feet two and three quarters inches high or thereabouts and (from the age expressed in said manumission) she will be thirty one years old in August next ensuing, of a dark brown complexion, was born and raised in Caroline County, has no notable mark or scar that I have observed.
