 Maryland & Caroline County, to wit whereas heretofore to wit on the fifth day of April Eighteen hundred and five, Thomas Roe Lee of Caroline County, by deed of manumission duly executed acknowledged and recorded amongst the records of Caroline County, did manumit and set free a certain negro girl called Henry, to be free and at liberty when she should arrive at the age of twenty five years which (from the age expressed in the manumission) she arrived to, in the month of July in the year eighteen hundred and eighteen, and whereas the same negro girl, now a woman, called Henry, hath made application to me for a certificate of her freedom agreeably to the act of assembly in such case made and provided, and I being satisfied by the oath of Philemon Spencer that the said negro girl (now a woman) for whom this certificate is made, is the identical person mentioned in the said manumission I do therefore grant her said application and hereby certify that the said negro woman Henry is five feet two and one quarter inches high or thereabouts her complexion nearly black, the end of the finger next to the little finger on the right hand marked off, was born & raised in Caroline County, and no other notable mark that I have observed.
