The State of Maryland Caroline County to wit, Whereas, heretofore to
 wit, on the eighth day of July in the year of our Lord, eighteen hun-
 -dred and five, Thomas Crew, by and of manumission duly executed
 acknowledged and recorded, amongst the records of said County, did man-
 -umit and set free a negro woman named Esther, to be free and at per-
 -fect liberty, from and after the first day of January, eighteen hundred
 and eighteen, and wherby the said negro woman named Esther
 hath made application to me for a Certificate of her freedom
 agreeably to an act of assembly in such case made and provided,
 and being satisfied by the oath of William Slaughter, of said
 County, that the said negro woman named Esther, for whom this
 Certificate is made, is the person mentioned in the manumission afo-
 re-
 I therefore grant her said application, and hereby certify that
 she is five feet three and three quarter inches high, or thereabouts
 and twenty seven years of age, or thereabouts, born and raised in
 Caroline County, her complexion is nearly black, she is almost
 blind in the right eye, the ball of which is of a bluish ^(white) color,
 and no other notable mark or scar that I have observed.

 hath been made to me, by a negro woman named Hannah Par-
 more, for a Certificate of her freedom, agreeably to an act of the
 General assembly of Maryland, passed at November session
 Eighteen hundred and five, by which said act free negroes and
 Molattos are permitted to travel out of this State, upon their
 obtention of a Certificate of being free born, and wherby also
 upon the oath of W. Cilia Craner of the County aforesaid,
 that the said negro woman, Hannah Parmore, for whom this
 Certificate is made, was free born, I do therefore grant her
 said application, and hereby certify that she is five feet
