State of Maryland, Caroline County to wit, Whereas, on the tenth day of July in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and nineteen, Joseph Talbott of Caroline County by deed of manumission duly executed acknowledged and recorded amongst the records of Caroline County, did manumit and set free a negro man named Andrew, to be free from the date of said manumission, as it appears of record, and whereas the said Andrew has made application to me for a certificate of his freedom, agreeably to the act of assembly in such case made and provided, and I being satisfied by the oath of Samuel Talbott of the County aforesaid, that the said negro man named Andrew, for whom this certificate is made, is the identical person mentioned in said manumission, I do therefore grant his said application, and hereby certify, that he is five feet four and three quarter inches high or thereabouts, about twenty eight years of age, born and raised in Caroline County, has a small scar on his left wrist, which he says was occasioned by being bit by his adversary in a fight, and has no other notable mark or scar that I have discovered.
