State of Maryland Caroline county to wit; Whereas application hath been made to me by a molatto man named Cato Capson for a certificate of his freedom agreeably to an act of the general Assembly of Maryland passed at November Session Eighteen hundred and five, by which said act free negroes & Molattos are permitted to travel out of this State upon their obtaining of a certificate of being free born, and whereas also upon the oath of Matthew Driver of Caroline county aforesaid, that the said Molatto man named Cato Capson, for whom this certificate is made, was free born, I do therefore grant his said application and hereby certify that he is five feet five inches high or thereabouts - says he ^{will be} twenty four years of age in March in the year eighteen hundred and twenty of a molatto complexion - was born and raised in Caroline county - and has not any notable mark or scar that I have observed.
