Caroline County Court

On the 29 of June 1807 a copy of the following was  
delivered to Negro Lender —

The State of Maryland Caroline County Court  
Whereas a certain Negro Woman by the name of  
Lender was manumitted by Mr. Wm Summers of  
said County on the 6 Nov. 1804 to be free from  
the date of said manumission, and whereas  
the said Lender made application to me for a cer-  
tificate of her freedom and from the affirmation  
of W. Seth Hill Esqrs that she is the identical  
person who was manumitted as aforesaid I certify that  
the aforesaid Negro Woman is about 5 feet <sup>and a half</sup> high  
has yellow complexion aged about 40 years was  
raised in the County aforesaid has a large scar on  
her right hand between her thumb and wrist  
and no other notable marks which I can dis-
