

State of Maryland Caroline county to wit; Whereas on the Twenty ninth day of October Eighteen hundred and twenty three, James Tatterfield negro of Caroline county by deed of manumission duly executed, acknowledged and recorded among the Land records of Caroline County, did manumit and set free a certain negro woman named Hannah, to be free from the date of the said manumission, and the said negro woman named Hannah having made application to me for a certificate of her freedom, agreeably to the act of assembly in such case made and provided, And whereas also upon the testimony of William Chaffinch of James County that the said negro woman named Hannah for whom this certificate is made is the same person mentioned in the said manumission. I do therefore grant her said application and hereby Certify, that she was thirty four years of age or thereabouts on the first day of May last, she is about five feet high of a molatto complexion, was born and raised in Caroline County and has a small scar on her left eye brow, and nearly parallel with the eye brow, a tolerably long scar on the inside of her right wrist, and nearly lengthways the wrist, and another long ^{one} scar across the upper part of the small of her right arm, and no other remarkable scar or mark that I have observed
