I do therefore grant his said application and hereby Certify that he was Nineten years of age the 25th day of Decmber 1823 he is five feet nine and a quarter inches high or thereabouts of a bright molatto complexion, was born and raised in Caroline County and has a scar on the middle joint of the fore finger of his right hand caused by a cut, which partially injures the use of the joint, and no other marks or scar that I have observed
