I do therefore grant his said application and hereby Certify that he was nineteen years of age the 25th day of December 1823 he is five feet nine and a quarter inches high or thereabouts of a light molatto complexion, was born and raised in Caroline County and has a scar on the middle joint of the fore finger of his right hand caused by a cut, which partially injures the use of the joint, and no other marks or scar that I have observed —

I do therefore grant his said application and hereby Certify that he ~~was~~ ^{is} ~~thirteen~~ ^{thirty} years & six months of age he is four feet nine and three quarters inches high or thereabouts of a dark molatto complexion, was born and raised in Caroline County and has a long scar over the outer corner of the right eye brow, the lower end of which is on a line nearly horizontal with the corner of the eye and no other marks or scar that I have observed —
