 of Stephen Lucas of Caroline County that the said negro girl named Hester
 Stanton for whom this Certificate is made was free born.

I do therefore grant her said application and hereby Certify that she
 will be twenty years of age in October next or thereabouts she is about four
 feet ten and a half inches high of a dark complexion was born and
 raised in Caroline County and has a scar of a burn on the top part of
 the left arm little below the elbow and no other marks or scars that

 Certificate of being free born, And whereas also upon the Oath of John Wilson of
 Caroline County that the said negro man named Nathaniel Groce for whom this
 certificate is made was free born. I do therefore grant his said application
 and hereby certify that he is five feet five inches high or thereabouts & he is
 about thirty - years of age, of a complexion ^{morely black} was born and
 raised in Caroline County and he is blind in his right eye occasioned
 by a burn, and no other mark or scar that I have observed.
