State of Maryland Caroline County to wit; Whereas heretofore to wit, on the seventh day of March in the year seventeens hundred & ninety one Richards Louckerman of Caroline County by Deeds of Manumission duly executed acknowledged and recorded among the Land records of Caroline County, did manumit and set free a certain negro woman named Nancy to be free in the year seventeens hundred & ninety five and the said negro woman named Nancy (now calling herself Nancy Palmer) having made applications to me for a Certificate of her freedom, agreeably to the act of Assembly in such case made and provided. And whereas also upon the Oath of Jonathan Corner of Caroline County, that the said negro woman named Nancy, is the same person mentioned in the said Manumissions. I do therefore grant her said Applications and hereby certify that she ^{was} ~~is~~ sixty two years of age the 7th day of March last or thereabouts, she is about five feet one and a quarter inches high of a dark brown complexion was born and raised in Caroline County and has a black mole on her forehead nearly over the inside corner of her left eye, a small scar on her left cheek bone, and a large scar on the left arm above the elbow and no other notable marks or scar that I have discovered. - In Testimony whereof I hereto subscribe my name & affix the public seal of my office this

State of Maryland Caroline County to wit; Whereas Application hath been made to me by a colored man named Matthew Nash for a certificate of his freedom, agreeably to the act of Assembly in such case made & provided by which said act free negroes and molattoes are permitted to travel out of this State upon the obtention of a Certificate of being free born. And
