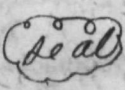
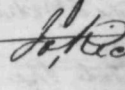

And whereas also upon the Oath of James Caulte of Caroline County that the said negro woman named Lydia Barney for whom this Certificate is made was free born I do therefore grant her said applications and hereby certify that that she is five feet ^{one} and an half inches high or thereabouts says she is about Twenty five years of age was born and raised in Caroline County and of a bright molatto complexion, has a very small mole under her left eye and no other particular mark or scar that I have discovered.
