I do therefore grant her said application and hereby certify that she is about Twenty four years of age, five feet one and a half inches high or thereabouts was born and raised in Caroline County and of a mulatto complexion has one small scar on her forehead over her right eye, two small scars on the inside of her right arm, one above and ~~one~~ the other below the elbow joint and a small black mole on the under lid of her left eye in the corner of the eye next to the nose and no other notable mark or scar that I have discovered
