a copy of which is as follows Viz

State of Maryland Caroline County to wit
Whereas application hath been made to me by a
mulatto man named William Johnson for a Certificate
agreeable to an Act of Assembly of the said State passed
at November Sessions Eighteen hundred and nine, by
which said Act free negroes and mulattoes are
permitted to travel out of the said State upon their
obtention of their being freeborn. And whereas also
upon the Oath of William Summers Esquire Gentlemen
of the County aforesaid, that the mulatto man
named William Johnson was freeborn; I do
therefore hereby certify that the said mulatto man
named William Johnson is five feet two inches
high of a yellow complexion, was born and
raised in the County of Caroline, has a large
scar on the back part of his left arm above
his elbow occasioned by a scald; and no
other marks which I can discover
