Goldsborough of Caroline County to be free at the time of the executing of the Deed of manumission as by the said Deed of manumission remaining of Record in Caroline County Court reference being thereto had, will more fully and at large appear And whereas also the said negro man named Will or (Will Chamberlain) hath made application to me for a certificate of his freedom agreeably to the act of assembly and upon the Oath of James Stumens that the said negro man named Will or, (Will, Chamberlain) is the identical person who was manumitted as aforesaid. I do hereby certify that the said negro man named Will or (Will Chamberlain) is five feet nine and three quarters inches high of a dark complexion, has no particular marks which I can discover In Testimony whereof I have hereto set
