by Mr. Charles Blain of Caroline County to be free on the first day of  
January one thousand eight hundred and six, as by the said Manu-  
-mission recorded in Lib. 3 R. No. 26 Folio's 178, 179 & 180 one of  
the said Records of the County aforesaid referred being thereto had well  
appear; and whereas application is made to me by a Negro Man called  
Glasgow (whom Doctor Robert Strong makes oath is the identical  
person who was Manumitted as aforesaid) for a Certificate of his freedom  
as aforesaid, I do hereby Certify that the said Negro Man called Gla-  
-sgow is five feet seven inches and a half high, and from the age expressed  
in the Manumission aforesaid he is about forty one years of age, is of a  
black Complexion, was raised till nearly grown in Dorchester County  
afterwards in Caroline, has a Scar on the lower part of the calf of his  
right leg - and no other notable marks which I can discover.
