is a well set fellow - has no remarkable marks which
I can discover In Testimony whereof I have
here to set my hand and affixed the public seal
of my office this fifth day of June in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Eleven

Rowan County, to wit. Be it remembered, that on the
twenty second October 1811 I delivered to Negro Elizabeth
a certificate as follow. Viz.
State of Maryland, Rowan County, to wit. Whereas
Negro Elizabeth otherwise called Elizabeth Thomas
desirous of travelling out of the County and State of her
nativity hath made application to me for a certificate
of her freedom agreeably to act of assembly in such case
made and provided. I do therefore upon the evidence
of Wm Thomas (Barcastle) satisfactory to my mind that the
said negro woman called Elizabeth otherwise Elizabeth
Thomas was born free, hereby certify that the said
negro woman from the evidence aforesaid, was born
free, that she was raised partly in Rowan & partly in
Talbot Counties, is now about twenty four years of
age - five feet two inches high - light complexion
has lost her upper jaw teeth and nearly all her lower
teeth, has a very remarkable scar occasioned (as she
says) by a burn, on the outer part of the left hand, about
the joints of the two last fingers - and no other notable
marks which I can discover. In Testimony whereof
