State of Maryland, Caroline County, to wit. Whereas a certain Negro
Man by the name of Sam, heretofore, to wit, on the twelfth day
of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
seven, was manumitted by Mrs Margaret Walker of Caroline
County, to be free from the date of said Manumission, as by the said
Manumission remaining of record in the County of reference
being thereto had will appear. and whereas application is made
to me by the said Negro Man called Sam, (whom I know is the
identical person who was manumitted as aforesaid) for a Certificate
of his freedom agreeable to act of Assembly. I do hereby Certify
that the said Negro Man called Sam is five feet one inch and
three quarters high, and from the age expressed in the Manu-
-mission aforesaid the said Negro Man called Sam is about thirty
three years of age, of a black Complexion, was raised in Caroline
County, has a small Scar on his right breast, which he says
was occasioned by a burn, and a Scar on his ^{right} arm, about four
five inches above his right hand, also a small narrow Scar
on his right Wrist - and no other notable marks which I can
discover. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and affixed the Seal of my Office this thirtieth
day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hun-
