A and 112 B, of Article 2, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel County," sub-title "County Commissioners," as the same were enacted by chapter 342, Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, Session of 1892, and to re-enact said sections 112 and 112 A, with amendments, and to repeal and re-enact with amendments, section 113, of Article 2, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel County," sub-title "County Commissioners," as the same was repealed and re-enacted with amendments, by chapter 515, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, Session of 1896, said sections as amended, fixing the number and compensation of the County Commissioners for Anne Arundel county and providing the time when the terms of all the present County Commissioners of Anne Arundel county shall cease and determine."

Senate bill entitled "An Act to provide for the appointment of a Board of Visitors for the Anne Arundel county jail, and defining the powers and duties of said board."

Senate bill No. 8, entitled "An Act to appropriate the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars for the use of the commissions appointed by the Governor to represent the State of Maryland at the South Carolina Inter-State and West Indian Exposition, to be held at Charleston, South Carolina, and the Pan-American Exposition to be held at Buffalo, New York."

Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by year and nays."

Senate bill entitled "An Act to appropriate a sum or money to pay the Electors of President and Vice-President of the United States, in and for the State of Maryland, their officers and attendants."
