REPORT:

The report of the Joint Conference Committee on the amendments to Senate bill, printed No. 9, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, section 270 G, sub-title 'Nominations,' sections 270 QQ, 270 RR, 270 TT, sub-title 'Ballots and Ballot Boxes,' and sections 270 CCC, 270 DDD, 270 HHH, and 270 AAAAA, sub-title 'Elections,' of chapter 2, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, of the Session of 1898, entitled an Act to repeal chapter 544 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Session, in the year 1894, entitled an Act to add new and additional sections to Article 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Frederick County,' sub-title 'Frederick,' relating to elections in Frederick city, and to enact in lieu thereof certain new and additional sections relating to the registration of voters and to elections in Frederick city aforesaid, to be added to said Article 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Frederick County," to follow section 270 A of said Article, and to be known as "Section 270 B," etc., respectfully recommends:

"That the House recedes from its amendments as follows:

"Section 270 QQ. In line 6, engrossed bill, after the word 'arranged,' insert the word "alphabetically.'

"In line 7, engrossed bill, after the word 'office,' add the words 'for which they are nominated,' and strike out the words 'in such uniform order as the Board of Supervisors may determine.'

"In line 9, engrossed bill, after the word 'ballot' and before the word 'shall,' insert the following: "And immediately to the left of the square opposite the name of the candidate and in line therewith.'"

"And substitute in lieu thereof the following amendments proposed by Conference Committee.

"Section 270 RR. In line 6 after the word "arranged" insert the words "alphabetically according to their surname."
