Now in Somersett County meret if they shall be found in your Bailewick and to the value of four pounds and  
five hundred pounds of tobacco and when you have the same attached or any part thereof the same in your  
Custody safe keep so that you have the same before the Justices of Our County Court to be held at Dividing Rock  
the third Tuesday of August next then and there to be tried and executed according to act of Assembly to and for the  
use of a certain Benjamin Cottman before the Said Thomas Maddocks by himself or his attorney shall appear  
and answer unto the said Benjamin Cottman in a case of trespass upon the said Cottman according to law and that  
by good and lawfull men of your Bailewick you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands  
you make the same attachment that he she or they be and appear before the Justices ~~without mentioning of~~  
our Said Court to be held as aforesaid to shew cause if any he she or they have why the same goods chattels lights  
or Creditors so attached in his hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and  
made according to the form of the act of Assembly in that case made and provided if to him her or them it  
shall seem meet and how you shall execute this writt that you make known unto our Said Justice  
at the day and place aforesaid have you then and there this writt witness Charles Ballard Gentleman  
Justice of our Said Court the 10 day of June in the eighth year of Our Domini 1723 Anno 1723

At which Said Third Tuesday of August to witt the twentieth day of the same month and hour one thousand  
and Seven hundred and twenty three being the day of the return of the said Writ Cometh the said Benjamin  
Cottman by his attorney aforesaid the Sheriff of Somersett County to whom the forgoing Writ was directed  
Likewise cometh and maketh return thereof to the Court here endorsed in these words following vizd  
By virtue of the within Writ so directed to the Justices herein mentioned I Certifie that I have attach-  
ed as the goods and chattels lights or Creditors of the Willm Name Thomas Maddocks in the hands of John  
Elsey the sum of four pounds curr. money and five hundred pounds of tobacco and I further Certifie  
that I have given Notice unto the said John Elsey that he be and appear before the Justices herein  
mentioned at the time and place aforesaid to shew cause if any he have why the same should not  
be condemned in his hands towards satisfying of the willm Name Benjamin Cottman his Damages and  
Cost against him recovered before Hugh Carter and John Doe good and lawfull men of my Bailewick  
as by the within Writ I am commanded to answer Joseph M Carter Sheriff

Whereupon the said John Elsey garnishee of the aforesaid Thomas Maddocks appears in his own proper  
person and says that he cannot garnishe but that he has of the lights and Creditors of the said Thomas Maddocks  
to the value of three hundred and forty eight pence to be paid in Law, but the same ought to be condemned  
in his hands for the loss of the said Benjamin Cottman as of the lights and Creditors of the said Thomas  
Maddocks which the said pifh does not garnishe

Whereupon the said Benjamin Cottman by his attorney aforesaid pray that the sum aforesaid so as aforesaid  
conferred by the aforesaid John Elsey as of the lights and Creditors of the said Thomas Maddocks may be condemned  
in his hands of the said John Elsey toward satisfying unto the said Benjamin Cottman as well the same
