first day of November in the year of Our Lord God One thousand Seven hundred and twenty at the place and County aforesaid and within the Jurisdiction of this Court was Indebted unto the aforesaid John in the sum of four pounds ten Shillings and three pence Court money of this Government for divers goods wares and merchandizes by the same Solomon unto the aforesaid Solomon at the special Instance and request of the same Solomon before that time there sold and delivered as by an account thereof here ready in Court to be produced may appear and so thereof being Indebted the aforesaid Solomon afterwards to wit the same first day of September November in the year aforesaid at the County aforesaid and within the Jurisdiction aforesaid in consideration thereof upon himself did assume and unto the aforesaid John then and there faithfully did promise that he the aforesaid Solomon the same four pounds ten Shillings and three pence in Indian Coin at twenty pence of Dutch into the same John when thereof afterwards he should be required well and faithfully would pay and Content Nevertheless the aforesaid Solomon his promise and assumption aforesaid so as it is said made nothing regarding But minding and fraudulently Intending the same John in this part craftily and subtilly to deceive and defraud the aforesaid four pounds ten Shillings and three pence or any part thereof unto the same John hath not paid or in any sort Contented altho' to doe the same the aforesaid Solomon afterwards to wit the twentieth day of March in the year of Our Lord God Seventeen hundred and twenty One and often afterwards at the County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction aforesaid by the aforesaid John he was required but that unto him hither to, to pay or in any sort to Content altogether hath refused and shall doth refuse to the damage of the same John of Nine pounds and Six pence Court money of this Government and thereupon he being with Suite & Costs

Whereupon the said Solomon Yearly alias Turpin in his own proper person Comes and defends, the force and injury above said and saith that he cannot justify the just his action aforesaid so as aforesaid against him brought nor can he say but that the said just ought to recover his damages by reason of the premises aforesaid to the sume of four pounds ten Shillings and three pence Court money and Costs of Suite against him which the said just does not justify. Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here the twentieth day of August and the One thousand Seven hundred and twenty three that the said John Scott recover against the said Solomon Yearly alias Turpin as well the sume of four pounds ten Shillings and three pence Court money of this Government certain damages aforesaid in form aforesaid Confessed as also the sume of Two hundred and fifty
