Tuesday of August next to satisfy unto Richard Holland as well the sum of Eleven pounds One Shilling six pence and
four hundred pounds of tobacco costs of suite together with all such Costs as to the said Sher. shall accrue upon this our Writ
of attachment and that by good and Lawfull meanes of your Bailiwick you make known unto the person or persons
in whose hands you make the same attachment that he she or they be and appear before the Justices of Our said
Court at the day and place aforesaid to shew cause if any he she or they have why the same good Chattels Rights or Credits
so attached shall not be condemned in his her or their hand according to Law for and towards satisfaction of the
and Costs above specified and now you shall execute this Writ that you make known unto Our said Justices at the
same day and place here affix not at your perill and have you then and there this Writ Witness Charles Ballard
