 Cometh and maketh return thereof to the Court here Endorsed in these words following vizt

Whereupon the said Cornelius Wooderson being called appears and thereupon the said Cornelius  
 Wooderson at the prayer of the plaintiff by his attorney aforesaid is adjudged to give Special Bail to the action  
 aforesaid Thereupon a certain William Young of Somerset County <sup>presently in Court in his proper person</sup> <sup>Chancellor under takes</sup> for the said Cornelius  
 Wooderson that in case the said Benjamin Waiter shall recover Judgment in the plea aforesaid against the said  
 Cornelius Wooderson, or that the said Cornelius Wooderson shall be therein Convicted that then he the said  
 Cornelius Wooderson shall pay the Condemnation of the Court thereupon or tender his Body to the Custody  
 of the Sheriff of Somerset County in Satisfaction thereof or that he the said William Young will do

 Cornelius Wooderson as well the Sum of Eleven hundred and twenty five pounds of Tobacco for his  
 (295) Damages aforesaid in form aforesaid as also the Sum of Two hundred and twenty five  
 pounds of Tobacco by the Court here adjudged unto him for his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit  
 in this Behalf Said Out and Expended and the debt in Money &c
