We command you that you attack any the good, Challes, lights or credits of Robert Citt late of all hollows Parish in Somerset County planter if they shall be found in your Bailiwick to the value of two thousand four hundred pounds of tobacco and when you have the same so attached or any part thereof the same in your custody safe keep so that you have the same before the Justices of Our County Court to be held at Dividing Creek in Somerset County aft the third Tuesday of August next then and there to be condemned according to act of assembly to and for the use of a certaine Robert Martin who left the said Robert Citt by himself or his attorney there appear and answer unto the said Robert Martin in a plea of trespass upon the case &c according to law and that by good and lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make knowne unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the same attachment that he she or they be and appear before the Justices of Our said Court to be held as aft to shew cause if any he she or they have why the same good, Challes, lights or credits so attached in his her or their hands Ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to the form of the act of assembly in that case made and provided if to him her or them it shall seeme uite and how you shall execute this writt that you make knowne unto the Justices of Our said Court at the same day & place aft and have them and there this writt witness Charles Ballard Gent Chief Justice of Our said Court the Nineteenth day of June in the eight year of Our dominion &c. At which said third Tuesday of August to witt the twentieth day of the same month and anno domini milledem
sever hundred and twenty three being the day of the returne of the said writt come to the said Robert Martin by his
attorney aft and the Sher. of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writt was directed likewise cometh and
maketh returne thereof to the Court here endorsed in these words following bid. By vertue of the written Writt he
me directed to the Justices within mentioned I certifie that I have attacked as the goods and Challes, lights or credits
of the written named Robert Citt to the value of one thousand and thirty pounds of tobacco (as appears by certaine
Schedule therof taken and hereto annexed) towards satisfying unto the written named Robert Martin his damage
and costs recovered against him the aforesaid Robert Citt as by the written Writt I am commanded to answer
an amount of sundry goods and Challes attached as the effects of Robert Citts Debts. Jos. McCarter Sher.

said Robert Martin the sume of two thousand four hundred pounds of tobacco aforesaid —

sever hundred and twenty three that the aforesaid Sheep, Cow & yearling & Cow and Calf of the value of one thous-
and and thirty pounds of tobacco aforesaid attached as the goods and Challes of the said Robert Citt be condemned in the
hands of Joseph McCarter & said Sher. and that his Lordship's Writ of Execution be given to the said
Sher.
