Plunder ab. dicitur Robert Citts of Somerset County in the province of Maryland if they shall be found in
your Bailiwick to the value of six pounds One Shilling and Seven pence Current money of this province
and Eight hundred pounds of tobacco and when you have the same attached or any part thereof the same
in your custody safe keep so that you have the same Before the Justices of Our County Court to be held at
Dividing Creek in Somerset County on the third Tuesday of August next then and there to be condemned according
to act of assembly to and for the use of certain William Whittington in aplea that he tender unto him six
pounds One Shilling and Seven pence Current money of this province & according to law and that by good &
lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make
the same attachment that he she or they be and appear before the Justices of Our Said Court to be held as
aff to shew cause if any he she or they have why the same goods chattels Rights or Credits so attached in his
her or their hands Ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to the
form of the act of assembly in that case made and provided if so in her or them it shall seem meet and
how you shall execute this writ that you make known unto the Justices of Our Said Court at the same
day and place aff and have you then and there this Writ witness Charles Ballard your Cheife Justice of
Our Said Court the Nineteenth day of June in the Eighth year of Our Dominion & Ann Dom: 1723 —
