avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. To the Sherif of Somerset County greeting Wee Command you that you
attach any the goods Chattels Rights or Credits of Robert Catts of County Parish in Somerset County
County ad. Sicut Robert Catts of Somerset County in the province of Maryland if they shall be found in
your Bailiwick to the value of Six pounds One Shilling and seven pence Curr. money of this province
and Eight hundred pounds of Tobacco and when you have the same attached or any part thereof the same
in your Custody Safe Keep so that you have the same Before the Justices of Our County Court to be held at
Disiding Creek in Somerset County at the third Tuesday of August next then and there to be condemned according
to act of assembly to and for the use of a certain William Whittington ^{with the said Robert Catts by himselfe or his attorney that appear and answer unto said William Whittington} in aglea that he tender unto him Six
pounds One Shilling and seven pence Curr. money of this province &c. according to Law and that by good &
Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make
the same attachment that he she or they be and appear before the Justices of Our Said Court to be held as
aft to shew cause if any he she or they have why the same goods Chattels rights or Credits so attached in his
her or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to the
form of the act of assembly in that case made and provided if to him her or them it shall seem meet and
how you shall Execute this Writt that you make known unto the Justices of Our Said Court at the same
day and place aft and have you then and there this Writt Witness Charles Ballard Gent Chief Justice of
Our Said Court the Twentieth day of June in the Eighth year of Our Dominion &c. Ann Dom: 1723 -
