Wherupon the said John Stewart in his proper Person comes and defends the force and Injury whene and say that he cannot give any Satisfaction of 20 as aforesaid against him brought nor can he say but that he said ought to recover his damages by Execution of the Commission aforesaid to the sum of four hundred and eighty pounds of tobacco and Costs of Suite against him which the said ought doth not give any

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here the Nineteenth day of March aforesaid and Done One thousand and seven hundred and twenty two that the said Robert Martin Recover against the said John Stewart as well the sum of four hundred and eighty pounds of tobacco (286) Damages aforesaid in full as aforesaid as also the sum of Two hundred eighty seven pounds of tobacco by the Court here adjudged unto him for his Costs and Charges by him about his Suite in this behalf Said Suit and Expended and to be paid in money

Court of Sommersett to be hold at Doding Creek the third Tuesday of March then next to answer unto the Right honorable Margaret Lady Baltimore Executrix of the last will and testament of the Right honorable Charles Lord Baron of Baltimore lately dead of age that he tender unto her six thousand pounds of good sound merchantable safe tobacco and Carque to Content the same which from her he unjustly detains and that thereof he should not fulfil And Wherupon the said Margaret Lady Baltimore by Francis Allen her attorney saith that whereas the said William Layton the grand fathered whose heir the above named William Layton dead was whose heir the above named William Layton now living is in his Life time to wit on the fourteenth day of May Anno Domini One thousand and Eighty Eight by his Certain Writing Obligatory acknowledged himself to be Bound to the Right honorable Charles Lord Baron of Baltimore in his Life time in two thousand four hundred pounds of good sound merchantable tobacco of the aforesaid six thousand pounds of good sound merchantable safe tobacco and Carque to be paid unto the said Right honorable Charles Lord Baron of Baltimore when he should be therunto required
