And whereas the said William Layton his grandfather in his life time to witt the twenty third day of October One thousand six hundred and Ninety four at d'Carish and County afof within the Jurisdiction of the Court by his certaine Other writing Obligatory did acknowledge him selfe bound unto the said Right hon'ble Charles Lord Baron of Baltimore in his life time in Nineleven hundred and Sixty pounds of good sound merchantable Loaf tobacco and Cakes to containe the same of the afof Six thousand pounds of good sound merchantable Loaf tobacco and Cakes to be likewise paid unto the said Right hon'ble Charles Lord Baron of Baltimore when he should be therunto required. And whereas also the said William Layton his grandfather the afof Twenty third day of October anno dñe One thousand six hundred and Sixty four afof at d'Carish and County afof within the Jurisdiction afof by his certaine Other writing Obligatory did acknowledge him selfe to be bound unto the said Right hon'ble Charles Lord Baron of Baltimore in his life time in Seven hundred and twenty pounds of good sound merchantable Loaf tobacco and Cakes the residue of the afof Six thousand pounds of good sound merchantable Loaf tobacco and Cakes to containe the same to be likewise paid to the said Right hon'ble Charles Lord Baron of Baltimore when he should be therunto required and by the said several writings Obligatory the said William Layton his grandfather died bind himselfe and his heirs Novembre last the said William Layton his grandfather nor the said William Layton his son and heir in their lifetimes nor the said William Layton son and heir of the last mentioned William Layton did the afof amounts required by the afof Six thousand pounds of good sound merchantable Loaf tobacco and Cakes to containe the same unto the said Right hon'ble Charles Lord Baron of Baltimore in his life time or to the said Margaret Lady Baltimore after the deaths of the said Right hon'ble Charles Lord Baron of Baltimore have not tendered but the same to them to London payed and the said William Layton his grandson and heir as afof the same to the said Margaret Lady Baltimore to London since dñe January and lawfully delaine to the said London by the Execution of the last will and testament afof whereupon the said said Sir Thomas Sackville was worse and hath damage to the value of twelve thousand pounds of tobacco and threypound the Bringe Suite and the Brings into Court here as witness.
