And the said Anne Nutt adm^e as afo^e by George Daskelle her attorney comes and defends the force and Injury when e^c and prays Leave to Imparte hereunto unles the Next Court and she hath it and the same day is given to the def^r also - At which said Next Court to wit the twentieth day of August and Dowd One thousand Seven hundred and twenty three Comes againe the said Richard Bennett by his attorney afo^e and prays that the said Anne Nutt adm^e as afo^e to his declaration in the plea afo^e may answer but the said Anne Nutt at the solemnly called Comes not But makes default where by the said def^r remains against the said def^r thereof indeforced e^c. But because it is not known what damages the said Richard Bennett hath sustained by occasion of the grants afo^e. Whereupon the Justices here at the prayer of the afo^e Richard and by the assent of the afo^e Anne doe afo^e the damages of the said Richard besides his costs and charges by occasion of the grants afo^e to four pounds twelve shillings and four pence halfe penny Court money e^c -

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here the twentieth day of August and Dowd One thousand Seven hundred and twenty three afo^e that the said Richard Bennett recover against the said Anne Nutt adm^e of the same Mathew Nutt as well the sume of four pounds twelve shillings and four pence halfe penny Court money Certain damages afo^e in form afo^e as also the sume of Two hundred Sixty Two pounds of tobacco by the Court here adjudged unto him for his costs and charges by him about his suite in this behalf said out and expended and to be levied of the goods and Chattels which were of the said Mathew Nutt at the time of his death in the hands of Anne Nutt adm^e as afo^e remaining to be administered if so much thereof in her hands she hath e^c and if so much thereof in her hands she hath not e^c. then the costs of suite afo^e to be levied of the proper good and Chattels of the said Anne Nutt e^c as afo^e in money e^c

W^t John Williamson } Command was given to the Sherd. of Somerset County that he should take William Mathews } Mathews Sen. late of all hollows parish in the County afo^e Esquire if he should be found in his Bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his Body Before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June then next to answer unto John Williamson of popplea of trespass upon the Case e^c and that thereof he should not forfeit e^c -

At which said ~~next~~ third Tuesday of June to wit the Eighteenth day of the same month and Dowd One thousand Seven hundred and twenty three Being the day of the return of the said Writ Cometh the said John Williamson by William Sargwell his attorney and the Sherd. of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed Likewise Cometh and maketh taken thereof to the Court here Entered in these words following vizt - Coggi Cypus ff Jos. MacCester Sherd -
