Whereupon the said Charles Ramsey by his attorney afo prays that for as much as he has Complied with the Law in Order to an attachment he may have Judgment against the said Robert Erry for his damages afo by way of attachment according to act of assembly &c. all whereupon for that it seems to the Court here that the said Charles Ramsey has Complied with the Law as alleged.

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here the twentieth day of August and Term. One thousand Seven hundred and twenty three afo that the said Charles Ramsey recover against the said Robert Erry as well the sum of thirty five Shillings Curr. money afo his damages by reason of the premises afo as all costs and charges by the said afo Laid Out and Expended about his Suit by way of attachment against the goods Chattels Rights or credits of the said Robert Erry according to act of assembly in such case made and provided &c.

And the said Thomas Dashiell by George Dashiell his attorney sets forth the Law of action against the said King Cooke in the plea afo as followeth viz. Somerset County ff. King Cooke Except you or your attorney appear the next August Court to be held at Durdunham the third Tuesday thereof to answer to Thomas Dashiell of a plea of Debt on Bond for five hundred pounds of tobacco attachment will lie against your goods if any to be found in Somerset County.
