Thereupon the said Richard Tule, Richard Elmsett & Robert Meloni all present here in Court acknowledged themselves to owe and stand Justly Indebted unto his Lordship the Lord proprietary his heirs and Successors in the Sum of five pounds Court money each for to be levied on the body's goods or Chattels Lands or Tenements for the Use of his said Lordship the Lord proprietary in case the said Richard Tule, Richard Elmsett and Robert Meloni do not make their personal appearance before the Justices of our County Court to be held at Dividing Tree in Somerset County on the third Tuesday of November Next to give Evidence against James Hewitt on behalf of the Lord proprietary for that he being suspected of uttering false &c

Ordered by the Court that the Sheriff of Somerset County Search the pockets of a certain James Hewitt & see whether he hath any Counterfeit Spanish Coin in his pockets &c

Whereas there being a debate between a certain William Robinson and a certain Daniell Cadory in Relation to a certain Orphan called Wm. Stevens & Mary Wharton &c and the Court having heard their several allegations. It is Ordered by the Court that that the said William Stevens continue under the Care & Tution of the said Daniell Cadory until such time as he shall be of full years of Age being his Guardian. the said Daniell Cadory to Learn him to read and write by the time he shall be of full years of Age being his Guardian &c. Thereupon it is Ordered by the Court that the said Daniell Cadory give Security for the performing of the same &c. Thereupon the said Daniell Cadory acknowledged himself to owe and stand Justly Indebted unto the said ~~Lordship the Lord proprietary~~ William Robinson his heirs and assigns in the Sum of twenty pounds Court money to be levied on his body goods or Chattels Lands or Tenements for the Use of the said William Stevens in case the said Daniell Cadory doth not Learn him to read and write by the time that he shall arrive to full years of Age being his Guardian &c

Like wise John Cadover and John Little of Somerset County acknowledged themselves to owe and stand Justly Indebted unto the said William Stevens his heirs and assigns in the full and Just Sum of five pounds Court money each to be levied on their body's goods, Chattels Lands or Tenements for the Use of the said William Stevens in case the said Daniell Cadory do not comply with the covenants of &c in Learning the said William Stevens to read and write by the time that he shall arrive unto full age of Learning his Guardian &c
