That the said Sum of One hundred and Sixty pounds of Tobacco so as aforesaid attached, be condemned in the
hands of the said Hugh Carter as of the rights and Credits of the said Robert Little towards Satisfying
unto the said Thomas Drummond and Mary his wife ad^o as aforesaid as well the Sum of two thousand two
hundred pounds of Tobacco their debt aforesaid as also the Costs accruing upon the writ of attachment aforesaid and that
the said Thomas Drummond & Mary his wife have thereof their Execution against the said Hugh Carter
according to act of assembly &c

Thomas Dashiell } memorandum the gift by his attorney Sh^oed out his Lordships writ of attachment against the
King Cool } Def^r the known whereof followeth in these words vizt. Somerset County so: Charles absolute
Lord and proprietary of the provinces of Maryland and avowed Lord Baron of Baltimore &c To the
Sherr^o of Somerset County greeting we Command you that you attach any the goods and Chattels Rights or
Credits of King Cool late of Somerset parish in Somerset County ad^o vizt. King Cool of Somerset County
and province of Maryland planter if they shall be found in your Bailiwick to the Value of Eighteen hund-
red pounds of Tobacco and when you have the same attached on any part thereof the same in your custody
Safe Keep so that you have the same before the Justices of our County Court to be held at Princetown in Som-
erset County aforesaid the third Tuesday of November next then & there to be condemned according to act of assembly
to aid for the use of a certain Thomas Dashiell unless the said King Cool by himself or his attorney appear
and answer unto the said Thomas Dashiell in plea that he owes unto him Nine hundred pounds of Tobacco
which to him he owes and from him he unjustly detains &c according to Law and that by good and Lawful
men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the
same attachment that he she or they be and appear before the Justices of our said Court to be held as
aforesaid to shew Cause if any he she or they shew why the same goods Chattels Rights or Credits so attached
in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to
the form of the act of assembly in that Case made and provided if to him her or them it shall seem
meet and how you shall Execute this writ that you make known unto our said Justices at the day &
place aforesaid and have you then & there this writ written of Charles Ballard Gent^o Chief Justice of our said
Court 24th day of Aug^r in Eighth Year of our Dominion &c and D^o 1723 - Thomas Heyward Esq^r

At which said third Tuesday of November to wit the Nineteenth day of the same month and D^o One
thousand Seven hundred and twenty three being the day of the return of the said Writ Cometh the said
Thomas Dashiell by George Dashiell his attorney and the Sherr^o of Somerset County to whom the foregoing
