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Or persons in whose hands you made the same attachment. That he She or they be & appear before the Justice of Our said Court to be held as aforesaid to show cause if any he She or they have why the same goods, Chattels, Rights or Credits so attached in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to the form of the act of assembly in that behalf made & provided if to him her or them it shall seem meet and how you shall Execute this writ that you make known unto Our said Justice at the day and place aforesaid and have you then and there this Writ Witness Charles Ballard Esq. Chief Justice of Our said Court the 24th day of August in the Eighth Year of Our Dominion &c. and Dated: 1723

At which said Tuesday of November to wit the Nineteenth day of the same month and Dated One thousand Seven hundred and twenty three being the day of the return of the said Writ Cometh the said Thomas Dashiell by George Dashiell his attorney and the Sheriff of Somerset County aforesaid to whom the foregoing writ was directed Likewise Cometh and maketh return thereof to the Court here Endorsed in these words following vizt

To the worshipful Justice within Mentioned Humbly Certifie that by virtue of the within Writ to me directed I have attached in the hands of John Copper the Sum of twelve hundred pounds of Tobacco as the Rights and Credits of the within Named Roberterry and I further Certifie that I have given Notice unto the said John Copper that he be and appear at the time & place within Contained to show cause &c. Before Matthew Hopkins and John Doe good and Lawfull men of my County with as by the within Writ I am Commanded so answer - For: My Master Sheriff -

Whereupon the aforesaid John Copper Garnisher of the aforesaid Roberterry appears in his own proper person and says that he cannot gainsay but that he has of the Rights and Credits of the said Roberterry in his hands to the value of four Barrells and halfe of Indian Corn, nor but the same ought to be condemned in his hands for the use of the said Thomas Dashiell which the said John does not gaining Whereupon the said Thomas Dashiell by his attorney aforesaid prays that upon giving Security according to aforesaid as of the Rights and Credits of the said Roberterry may be condemned in the hands of the said John Copper towards Satisfying unto the said Thomas Dashiell his damages &c. as also all costs accruing upon the writ of attachment aforesaid
Whereupon George Dashiell of Somerset County Esq. presents before me Court undertakes for the said Thomas Dashiell according to act of assembly that in Case the said Roberterry doe at any time within a year and aday appear and make due or any part of the Claim of the said Thomas Dashiell appear to be satisfied or to have been made before the day of this attachment. That then he the said Thomas Dashiell shall make restitution unto the said Roberterry of all or such part as shall be made appear to be undue or that he the said George Dashiell will do it for him &c.

Therefore it is Considered by the Justice here the Nineteenth day of November and Dated One thousand Seven hundred and twenty three that the said Sum or quantity of four Barrells & halfe of Indian Corn &c. so as aforesaid be condemned in the hands of the said John Copper as of Rights & Credits of the said Roberterry towards Satisfying unto the said Thomas Dashiell his damages &c. as also all costs accruing upon writ of attachment aforesaid & that the said Thomas Dashiell have his Execution there of at the said John Copper according to act of assembly &c.
