Edward Short or that the said Edward Short shall be thereto Convent that then he the said Edward Short
shall pay the Condemnation of the Court thereupon or tender his Body to the custody of the Sher^{of} of Somerset
County in satisfaction thereof or that he the said Adam Hiltch will do it for him thereupon the said
Edward Short by Francis Allen his attorney appears & Impugnes &c

Command was given to the Sher^{of} of Somerset County that he should take Richard
Tiler and William White of Somerset County alias dictus Richard Tiler and William
White of Somerset County and province of Maryland planters if they shall be
found in his Body with and then should safe keep so that that he should have their Body before the
Justices of his Lordship County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek in Somerset County the third
Tuesday of November next to answer unto Christopher Nutt of plea that they tender unto him the just
quintity of two pounds twelve Shillings and ten pence which to him they owe & unjustly detain &c
and that there of he should not fail &c

At which said third Tuesday of November to wit the Nineteenth day of the same month and
Dowd One thousand seven hundred and twenty three Being the day of the return of the said writ Cometh
the said Christopher Nutt by George Dethell his attorney and the Sher^{of} of to whom the foregoing writ
was directed Likewise Cometh and maketh return thereof to the Court here Enact in these words following
viz.

Whereupon the said Richard Tiler and William White in their own proper persons comes and defend
the force & injury where of and says that they cannot answer the p^lff the action a^d nor can they say but
that the said Christopher Nutt's writing obligating a^d in repair and deed and that the debt
there mentioned is lost due & unsatisfied wherefore the said p^lff prays Judgment for his debt a^d
and his costs and damages sustained by reason of the same debt to him to be adjudged

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here the Nineteenth day of November and Dowd One
thousand seven hundred and twenty three a^d that the said Christopher Nutt Recover against the
said Richard Tiler & William White as well the sum of two pounds Eight Shillings ^{and ten pence} his debt a^d as also the
sum of Two hundred & Ninety Six pence of costs by the Court here
adjudged unto him for his costs and damages sustained by reason of the detaining of the same debt to
him to be adjudged &c
