And where upon the said Robert by William Foxworth his attorney complains that whereas on the 8th of Richard & seventeenth day of March and done One thousand Seven hundred and twenty two at allholmes parish in the County of Kent within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted unto the same Robert in the quantity of One thousand and fifty three pounds of tobacco for Rent due as by an ant. thereof here with into Court brought may appear and being so thereof indebted he the same Richard in consideration thereof upon himself assumed and to the same Robert then & there faithfully promised that he the same Richard the said One thousand and fifty three pounds of tobacco unto the same Robert when he should be afterwards there to required would well and truly content and pay Never the less the said Richard his promise and assumption of in form of made Little regarding but minding and fraudulently Intending the said Robert in this part rashly and subtilly to deceive & defraud the said One thousand and fifty three pounds of tobacco or any part thereof unto the said Robert altho' the same Richard by the same Robert at allholmes parish in the County of Kent within the said Jurisdiction the two and twentieth day of March and done seventeen hundred and twenty three hath been required hath not paid but the same to him hitherto to pay hath refused and still doth refuse to the damage of the said Robert two thousand and six pounds of tobacco and thereof brings Suit &c.
