The condition of this obligation is Such that if the above Bound Joseph McCarter do well & truly Serve the right honorable the Lord proprietor of this province his heirs & Successors in the Office of High Sheriff of the County of Somerset within the province of Maryland &c and in all things well & faithfully Execute the same Office and also majoritys rights and duties his Officers above full fee & profit amount of all & singular his said Lordships Majestys Governours and Other his Officers within this province to receive & collect his amount and his said and Other dues belonging to his said Majestys Governours as also his own of full fees due & sums of money or tobacco due to any the good people within this province for any sum or sums of money or tobacco due where with the said Sheriff be Entrusted during the time of his Sherifalty for the present or to such of them as he shall request require the same shall pay & render by the tenth day of may next Comencing the date thereof
