 next and stand and abide the Judgment of the Court then this Recognizance to be void Else to remain
 in full force & Virtue in Law - - - - John Hardy -

Now here at to wit the third Tuesday of March being the Seventeenth day of the same month
 and Term One thousand Seven hundred & twenty three personally appeared here in Court the above-
 Named James Driskill, and prays that his appearance may be Entered to save himself and -
 Security from the above Recognizance - thereupon the said James Driskill's appearance is Entered
 and he accordingly discharged therefrom &c. Whereupon It is Ordered by the Court that the
 said James Driskill give New Recognizance for his good behaviour and appearance at next Court
 in the Sum of fifty pounds Curr. money, with One Security in the same Sum &c.

thereupon the said James Driskill present here in Court acknowledged himself to owe & stand
 Justly Indebted unto his Lordship the Right honourable the Lord proprietary his heirs and
 Successors in the Sum of fifty pounds Curr. money to be Levied on his Body Goods, or Chattels, Lands,
 or tenements for the Use of his said Lordship the Lord proprietary his heirs & Successors - In Case
 the said James Driskill doe not make his personall appearance before the Justices of our County
 Court to be held at Dividing Creek in Somerset County the third Tuesday of June next to answer unto
 all such matters and things as shall be then & there objected against him on his Lordships behalfs
 and to stand & abide the Judgment of the Court thereupon and not to depart the same Court without
 License thereof and in the mean time to be of the Good Behaviour to all his Lordships Loyal People
 Especially to the said Sarah Wright &c.

Likewise Moses Driskill of Somerset County Clerk present here in Court in his proper person
 undertakes for the said James Driskill as his Surety and acknowledged himself to owe and stand
 Justly Indebted unto his said Lordship the Lord proprietary his heirs and Successors in the Sum of fifty
 pounds Curr. money to be Levied on his body Goods or Chattels, Lands or tenements to the Use of
 his said Lordship his heirs and Successors - In Case the said James Driskill doe not make his personall
 appearance before the Justices of our County to be held at Dividing Creek in Somerset County the
