Read) is instantly demanded how he would acquitt himself of the premises aforesaid imposed upon him, say
that of the premises aforesaid he is guilty thereof & submits to the mercy of the Court, but hath not wherewith all to pay
his fine for the said aforesaid. Wherefore it is considered by the Justices here that the said John Sayler be whipt
with fifteen Lashes on the Bare back well laid on while the blood appear, and thereupon as to the corpo-
-rall punishment aforesaid is given to the Sher. of Somerset County that he do thereof immediate Execution
according to the Judgment aforesaid rendered by Whipping the said John Sayler at the Publick whipping post with fifteen
Lashes on the Bare Back well laid on while the blood appear - afterwards in the same Court the Sher. that he
had done the Execution of the Judgment aforesaid as to the corporal punishment aforesaid he was commanded - Whereupon it is
Ordered by the Court that the said John Sayler serve his said Master Jeffery Long three full months to commence
at the Expiration of his Servitude ^{adjudged} it being for full Satisfaction, for the damage, trouble & loss of time that the
said Long was at, in the time of the said Katherine Ryne's Child bearing & Nursing of the same Child & Like-
-wise it is ordered by the Court that the said Jeffery Long give Security to return the said John Sayler to the
County Court or the Sher. of the County at the Expiration of his Servitude to be bound to the Court by the said
-all Officers their fees that accrued by action of the premises &c. Thereupon the said Jeffery Long being
acknowledged himself to owe & stand Justly Indebted unto his Lordship the Lord proprietary his heirs & Success-
-ors in the Sum of ten pounds Curr. money to be levied on his body goods, or Chattels, Lands or tenements &c.
In Case the said Jeffery Long doe not return the said John Sayler to the County Court or the Sher. of the
County at the Expiration of his Servitude to be bound to the County the several Officers their fees due by
action of the premises aforesaid &c.

His Lordship } Somerset County sh. Whereas this day to witt the 14th day of December 1723 (some Richard
Richard Driskill) Driskill before me John Handy one of his Lordship's Justices the Lord proprietary Justices
of the peace for the said County to Keep with his Security Moses Driskill and did acknowledge
themselves to be Indebted to his Lordship each in the Sum of ten pounds Curr. money due to be levied on their
goods and Chattels, Lands or tenements for the Use of his said Lordship &c.
The Condition of the above Recognizance is Such that if Richard Driskill do make his per-
-sonall appearance before the Justices of Somerset County Court to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday
of March next to answer unto all Such things as shall be objected against him by Hannah Ford on behalf
of his said Lordship and stay and abide the Judgment of the said Court that this Recognizance to be void Else
to remain in force & Virtue in Law

Whereupon the said Richard Driskill in his own proper person appears, and is discharged from
the Recognizance aforesaid. Thereupon the Richard Driskill is ordered to give New Recognizance for
his good Behaviour and appearance at Next Court Whereupon the said Richard Driskill together
with Moses Driskill his Security both present in Court acknowledged themselves to owe and stand
Justly Indebted unto his said Lordship the Lord proprietary in the Sum of ^{ten} pounds Curr. Money
