Whereas there was an Order delivered a certain Andrew Lankey on Joseph Markles the high Sheriff of
Somerset for five pounds Ninteen Shillings and five pence, to be paid unto the said Andrew Lankey out
of the fines for fornication for carrying, and the said Andrew Lankey Endorsed the same Order
to a certain George Dashiell, but the said George Dashiell demanding the said Money of the said Markles
could not get the same, Now here at this day to wit the seventeenth day of March and one

against the Grace of our Lord Proprietary his good rule & dignity Leon Gale of Don't Cross -
For the same brought on by the said Wm Robinson & the said Leon Gale & the said Adam Heath foreman
On the Back of the foregoing Oath it was then Endorsed by the said Vice Vera Adam Heath foreman

Thereupon command is given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the said
William Robinson if &c to answer &c And Now hereafterwards to wit the same Day & Year comes the
said William Robinson in Custody of the Sheriff; into whose Custody before that time was committed and
being by the Sheriff sett to the Bar is thereupon Instantly demanded how he would acquitt himself of
the premises &c above imposed upon him says that of the premises &c upon him imposed he is
