half an hour and after ward. in the same Court the Sher^{ff} returns that he has done the Execution of the Indict^{mt} aft^r
as to the Corporate Commitment. aft^r he is Commanded - and further it is Considered by the Justices that the said
William Robinson suffer Imprisonment Eighteen day for the fact aft^r, and after ward. to remain in Custody of
the Sher^{ff} untill he shall be discharged thence by the Court of Law &c

Ordered by the Court that M^r Joseph M^r Foster stand Chargeable to the County for five pound. Nineteen Shill^{ings} and
five pence for fines &c
