The Condition of the above Obligation is Such that if the above Bound Whereas the Consistory General hath transmitted unto this Court the account of the Estate of Daniel Jones deceased: where in it is found that there is Debt: Due to the above said Orphan the sum of ninety five pounds nine Shillings & Six pence fur Money if therefore the said William Story his Executors and Assignes do and Shall well & truly pay & Satisfie unto the said Orphan the said sum of ninety five pounds nine Shillings & Six pence when they shall attain to full Seven years according to act of Assembly now in force then the above Obligation to be void Else to Remain in full force and Virtue
