Robert Martin } Commanded was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take Anthony More
 agt. } of Cowdry Parish in the County of Somerset Clerks if he should be found in his Balance
 Anthony More and him should safe keep so that he might have his Body before the Justices of the Peace:
 Super County Court of Somerst to be held at Duxling Green the third Tuesday of March next to answer
 unto Robert Martin of a sum of money exacted upon his Case & that then of his should not fail
 And wheresupon the Said Robert by Francis Allen his attorney Complains that Whereas the Said

Anthony the Thirtieth day of November Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and twenty two at the Parish
 and County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted unto the Said Robert in Eight hundred and
 forty six pounds of tobacco for Lovies Shews fees Publick dues and perbair and heringage to the Said
 Robert when and where did owing and unpaid as by an act of Assembly made in Court appear
 and being so therof Indebted the Said Anthony in Consideration thereof afterwards to witt the day and year
 aforesaid whereupon he did assume and to the Said Robert when and where did faithfully promise
 that he the Said Anthony the aforesaid Eight hundred and forty six pounds of tobacco to the Said Robert when he
 should goe forwardwards he would require him to pay and to be left the Said
 Said Anthony his promise and assumption of payment made little regarding but clothing and prudel-
 ly Intending the Said Robert in that part craftily and subtlely to drawe and defraud the aforesaid
 hundred and forty six pounds of tobacco to the Said Robert he hath not paid or to him for the same in any
 wise Contented altho' he same to do the Said Anthony by the Said Robert on the first day of December in the year
 aforesaid afterward at the Parish and County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction aforesaid he was thereto
 requested but the same to him to pay or in any wise to content him refused and still doth refuse and deny
 whereupon the Said Robert saith he is worth and hath damage to the value of Sixteen hundred and
 (Ninety)
