One thousand Seven hundred and twenty being the day of the return of the said Writ Comes the said Robert Martin by his attorney att and the Sheriff of Sommersett County to whom the foregoing Writ was directed Likewise Comes and answers to the said Writ in these words to wit. That Joseph Mee Clerk of the Court

Whereupon the said Robert Martin by his attorney att Cray, that for as much as he has Complied with the Law in Order to an attachment he may have Judgment against the said Anthony More for his damages att by way of attachment amounting to out of Assembly &c. Whereupon for that it seems to the Court here that the said Robert Martin has Complied with the Law as alleged,

Therefore it is Considered by the Justice

here the Nineteenth day of March And Dow. One thousand Seven hundred and twenty two att that the said Robert Martin Crown against the said Anthony More as wote the Sum of Eight hundred and forty six pounds of Tobacco his damages by Creation of the Crown for att as all costs and Charges by the said Robert Martin paid and Expended about his Suit by way of attachment against the good, Credits and Credits of the said Anthony More amounting to out of Assembly in such Case made and provided &c.

John Caldwell - Command was given the Sheriff of Sommersett County that he should take John Layton and George Hutchins both of Stopney Parish in the County of Dorset if they should be found in his Parish and them should safe keep so that he might have them before the Justice of his Lordships County Court of Sommersett the third Tuesday of March then next to appear unto John Caldwell of a plea of trespass upon the Case and that they should not fail &c.

And the said John Caldwell by Francis Allen his attorney proceeded against the said John Layton and George Hutchins in the Court att as followeth - to wit. And whereupon the said John Caldwell by Francis Allen his attorney complains that whereas the said John Layton and George Hutchins the tenth day of March in the year of our Lord God One thousand Seven hundred and Nineteen twenty at the Parish of Stopney and County and within the Jurisdiction of this Court were indebted unto the said John Caldwell in a Sum of five hundred and twenty pounds of Tobacco by the said John Caldwell to a certain Alexander Carlyle for him the said George Hutchins at the request and request of him the said George Hutchins that he deposited and paid verily unto the said John Caldwell to be produced by them the said John Layton and George Hutchins signed may appear and thereupon being judged the said John Layton and George Hutchins afterwards to wit the
